Gopal Boro HS School

Illegal vegetable market causing inconvenience

GUWAHATI, Sept 4: The unauthorised vegetable market running outside the Gopal Boro Government Higher Secondary School in Ganeshguri is causing inconvenience to the students, teachers and staff of the school.

School authorities said that the street vendors attract a large number of visitors which leads to noise pollution, affecting the regular classes of the school.

Principal (In-charge) of the school, Indrani Talukdar told *The Assam Tribune* that a portion of the guard wall of the school is on the verge of collapse due to the market.

"Despite several complaints to the authorities concerned in the past, we have not seen any fruitful results till date. We have to run the school amid the cha-

os every day," she said.

"The vendors even throw vegetable wastes inside the school, without giving any thought to the health and hygiene of the students. Our sweeper has to put extra effort to keep the campus clean every day. We want a permanent solution to this problem," she added.

She, however, said that they are expecting that the present scenario would improve as the Dispur Police Station recently shifted to a new location in front of the school.

Even though the market running along the footpath of the Gopal Boro Government Higher Secondary School is creating huge traffic jam on the Dr RP Road in Ganeshguri, the Guwahati Municipal Corporation (GMC) and other government agencies have failed to relocate the vendors to a different place and keep

the street free from traffic snarls.

Unauthorised parking and illegal rickshaw stands also add to the woes of the school authority.

She further said that the school has been functioning without a chowkidar including a night chowkidar for the last two years.

"As a makeshift arrangement, our midday meal cook has been assigned the task. We have provided accommodation to him inside the school," she said.

Moreover, three subject teacher posts at the higher secondary level and seven posts at the high school level have been lying vacant.

She also pointed out that enrolment in the school has been rising over the years which is a good sign for the government school.

"There are 850 students in Class VI to Class XII in the school," she said.

Book on Ahom justice delivery system released

GUWAHATI, Sept 4: *Administration of Justice During Ahom Rule (1228-1826 AD): Its Legacy in India Today*, a book penned by former advocate general and academician Dr Romesh Chandra Borpatra Gohain was released here today.

Chief Justice of Gauhati High Court, Justice Rashmin Manharbhai Chhaya, Justice BK Sarma and Prof Jogendra Nath Phukan released the book at an event held at the Vivekananda Kendra Institute of Culture. The book is published by DVS Publishers.

The book is an outcome of the writer's intensive research on the subject, which also throws light on various facets of legal history of the Ahom kingdom, which con-

tinued for 600 years and is still unrivalled.

The book also dwells on strong aristocratic polity and unique justice delivery system of the Ahoms. They practised unmatched jurisprudential principles in revenue, civil and criminal justice system, where, even the King (Swar-gadeo) could be prosecuted for violating any of the five codes of conduct.

"In the book, I have discussed about various aspects of justice delivery system of the Ahom kingdom, including the definitions of different offences of that time. Notably, the British rulers were also inspired from the justice delivery system of the Ahoms. Moreover, I have also discussed foreign policies, environment and wildlife laws, land system, laws related to wom-

en safety of the Ahom era in the book," the writer said.

Releasing the book, Justice Chhaya praised the writer for the research work. He stated that the book will help the future generations in conducting further research and study in the field. He also hoped that the book will get acceptance among readers as soon as it hits the stands.

Addressing the event, Prof Phukan marked the era of Ahom rule as very solid, constructive and glorious. He also congratulated the writer for the extensive research work.

In his speech, Justice BK Sarma discussed about various aspects of administration of justice of Ahom rule that the book has covered. Judges of Gauhati High Court, senior members of the Bar and others graced the occasion.

Noted folklorist Dr Prabin Ch Das passes away

GUWAHATI, Sept 4: Noted folklorist, former teacher of Gauhati University Dr Prabin Chandra Das breathed his

last at a city-based private hospital late last night. He was 80. Das had a brain stroke recently.

A stalwart of folklore research of Assam, Dr Das had also served as a teacher in Pandu College and St Edmund's College, Shillong, and as a visiting fellow in Dibrugarh University and NEHU, Tura campus. He also served as Director of Students' Welfare and secretary, University Classes of Gauhati University.

Dr Das had a number of books to his credit, including *Punyabumi Hajo*, *Asamiya Bhasa Aru Sahityar Katha*, *The Blessed Land*, etc. He also edited and co-authored a number of books in his lifetime.

Today, his mortal remains were brought to the University campus, where students, teachers and employees paid their last respects to their former teacher. His last rites were performed at Bhoonath crematorium this evening.

Education Minister Ranaj Pegu, AASU chief advisor Dr Samujjal Bhattacharya and former advocate general and educationist Ramesh Borpatragohain, among others, have consoled his demise.
